Notes on Sires

- 150313**
- Bright, white, stylish, weather resistant wool
 - Extremely predictable and consistent sire with enough performance to top 2 sire evaluations
 - Nearly 800 progeny recorded with SGA
 - Used in reference flock, MSS and MLP
 - Great ram for improving wool quality, without sacrificing production
 - High profit twin who's brother was sold to Uruguay
 - They were the first lambs out of an exciting 68 daughter

- A sound TWIN with great shape which is reflected in his carcase ASBVS
 - 55 has outstanding long, soft, white wool and great feet
 - One of the most unique ASBV profiles in the industry
 - Great pedigree with high fleece value, strong carcase, and cost of production traits
 - Progeny grow quickly, are heavy cutting and exhibit lot's of shape before tapering off to a sensible and profitable mature ewe size

- Very popular sire with over 2000 progeny tested in his first 2 years of use
 - Their performance has underpinned his importance to the industry
 - New data from MLP project has completed the picture with a top 1% NLW ASBV
 - He gets his superior wool quality from his 070441 dam and his cut and body shape from his sire CP204
 - Wool is ideally nourished, extra soft, white and crimpy with a great tip
 - 70 exhibits extra length, has good feet and excellent overall confirmation with an optimal maturity pattern and negative WEC
 - 70 combines price (Top 5%-FD) and production (Top 1% -CFW) with high accuracies (96%) better than any proven ram in the industry

Notes on Sires ... cont

 - A ram that does the fleece value, carcase and COP traits better
 - Increase fleece value with top 10% CFW and 5% FD
 - Improve carcase top 30% FAT EMD
 - Improve WEC top 30%
 - Improve profit
 - Stylish, dense, elite wool

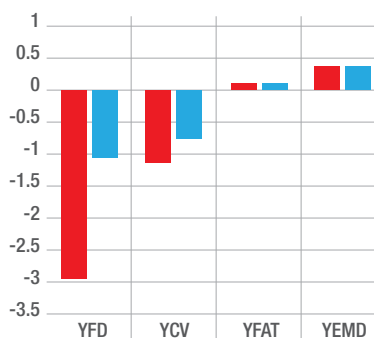
- 190110**

 - Best woolled son with impeccable structure and low wrinkle
 - Large frame with a great balance of fleece traits, WEC and acceptable carcase

- 190193**
- The phenotypic stand out of the 19 drop
 - Sire 63 has done a great job in stamping progeny with a superior, consistent "weather-proof" wool
 - Open faced ram with carcase, extension and mobility
 - White, bright, stunning yet productive wool
 - An important sire to re-enforce wool quality, phenotype and carcase traits

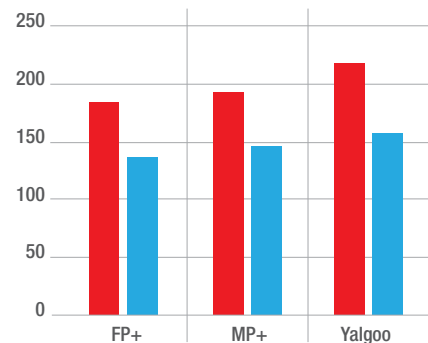

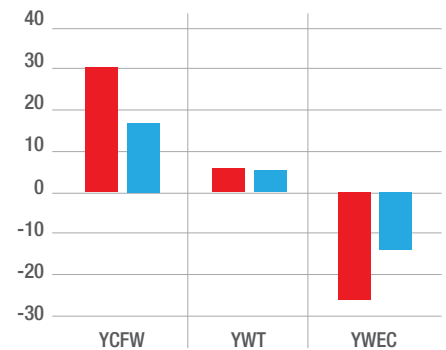


Profit Indexes
