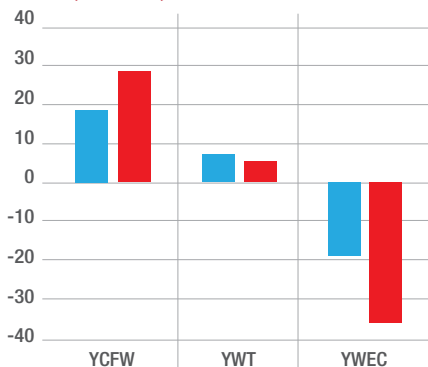

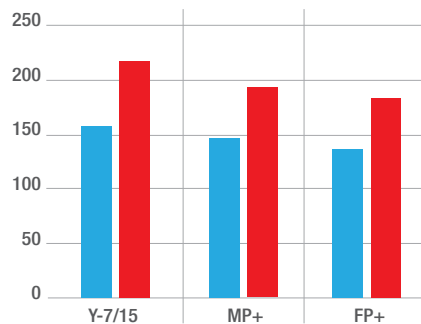

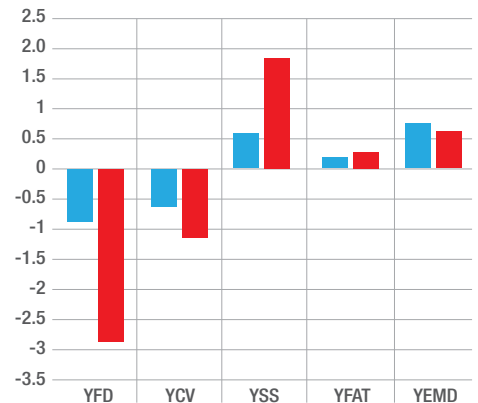


■ Average Yalgoo Semen Sire ■ Average Merino 2022 Drop
